Toni's responsibility is to lead the Institute for Learning (IfL), the professional body for over 200,000 teachers and trainers across further education and skills in England. The IfL has a major focus on continuing professional development for teachers and trainers, and promotes teachers' dual professionalism as teachers and experts in their subject or vocational area.

Toni qualified as a professional teacher almost 30 years ago and taught in adult and further education, schools and prisons. She also led a large local authority adult education service, and was a full-time inspector at the Further Education

Funding Council for seven years specialising in skills for life and humanities, as well as governance and management.



She was a Director of Quality in the national LSC office, covering the breadth of the sector and across, the then, 47 local learning and skills councils and leading on one of four themes for the Success for All policy around funding, planning and performance. For four years Toni also worked as a senior civil servant and led the Success for All theme of teaching and learning, as well as further education workforce, personalisation and quality assurance.
